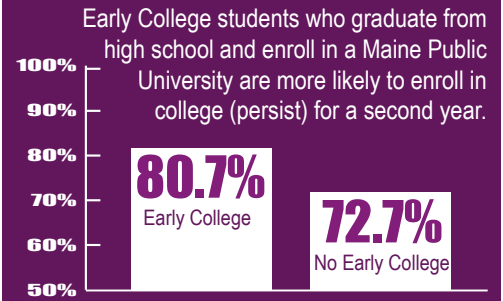


EARLY COLLEGE STUDENTS:

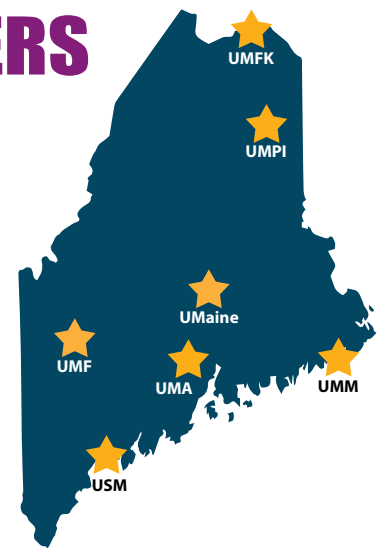
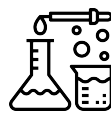
EARN A DEGREE IN LESS TIME.
